The Role

As a Special Fundraising Events Volunteer, you will play a key role in helping Shelter Movers execute impactful and successful fundraising events. In this role, you will assist with event logistics, guest services, donation processing, and ensuring a seamless experience for event attendees.

- Raise awareness for Shelter Movers' mission, foster community engagement, and contribute to the organization's ability to fundraise and support those in need.

Responsibilities and Accountabilities

- Assist with setting up and tearing down event venues, including arranging seating, decor, and equipment
- Help with logistics and tasks leading up to the event
- Welcome and assist quests during the event, providing information or directions as needed
- Support registration/check-in processes and distribute event materials
- Ensure smooth event operations by monitoring activities and assisting with payment and donation processing
- Provide general support to the event team, ensuring tasks are completed efficiently and everyone is informed
- Assist with post-event clean-up, including collecting and organizing event materials.
- Support the collection of donations and payments on-site, handling transactions securely and responsibly

Skills and Qualifications

- Outgoing, confident, and comfortable engaging with guests and stakeholders, both in-person and through various communication channels
- Strong interpersonal skills with a friendly, approachable attitude with the ability to build relationships with a diverse group of individuals
- Strong communication skills both written and verbal



- Trustworthy and responsible, particularly with handling money and sensitive information
- Confident using technology, specifically computer-based payment processing systems
- Ability to work collaboratively as part of a team and follow direction
- Experience in hospitality or customer service is an asset
- Ability to multitask and stay organized in a fast-paced environment
- Flexibility to adapt to changing event needs and tasks
- Ability to be active during the event, which may include staying in one place or moving around for extended periods
- Comfortable navigating new environments and physical spaces
- The ability to commit to full-day events is preferred, but not essential
- Previous event experience is preferred, but not required
